Outline Itinerary

Friday 6th April

Depart in the morning from your chosen pick up point, ferry crossing then arrive Holland afternoon/evening.

Saturday 7th April

Group games are played today, it is usual for your fixtures to be played in the morning or afternoon therefore giving you time for sightseeing, e.g Amsterdam Arena, Duinrell

Sunday 8th April

Tournament continues today and your team will play in the A finals or B finals (plate).

Monday 9th April

Depart around lunchtime, arrive local area in the evening.

Extend your stay by an extra night for just £20 per person allowing you to have Monday free for sightseeing or a free day at Center Parcs.



Transport

Executive coach with video, wc and hot drinks facility included free of charge for groups of 25 persons or more. Smaller groups will have luxury standard coaches suitable for the size of their party; upgrades to executive vehicles are available.

Sailings are also available via Harwich – Hook (£25 per person), Hull - Rotterdam (£50 per person) and Newcastle – Amsterdam (£50 per person).

The most suitable airport to fly into is Amsterdam Schipol, we can arrange transfers from here to your accommodation (approximately 30 minutes) and sports grounds.

Accommodation

Center Parcs Zandvoort is situated 5/10 minutes from the beach, the centre of the resort and the train station, which has direct links into Amsterdam. A highlight of the centre is the newly renovated sub tropical pool complex, and the sports club includes bowling and tennis. There are several bars and restaurants on site.

Additionally other types of accommodation are available, including youth hostels and hotels of all grades, on the Dutch coast and in Amsterdam.

Age dispensations may be applied for English teams due to UK age groups running from September to August (your ISL office can assist with this).



All teams are split into groups of 4 or 5 and play each other on the first day. On the second day you play in the A or B (plate) finals. Teams normally play 4 games each day of 2 x 10 minutes. Winners and runners up receive a team trophy; all participants receive a souvenir pennant.



The football is played in historic Haarlem and venues have clubhouses, serving snacks and drinks, changing facilities and first aid.



2012 marks the 22nd annual Holland Easter Cup. Over a 100 teams from many different countries will participate in one of Europe's largest Easter soccer tournaments.



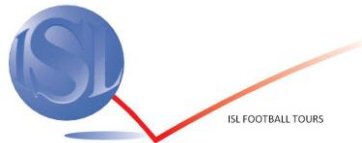
There is a team leaders meeting on the Friday evening at the tournament headquarters, and on the Saturday and Sunday there are great opportunities to meet people and teams from other countries.
