Typical Itinerary

Friday 6 th April	Depart in the morning, arrive Holland afternoon/evening.
Saturday 7 th April	Group games are played today, it is usual for your fixtures to be played in the morning or afternoon therefore giving you time for sightseeing, e.g. PSV / Vitesse Arnhem Stadium visits, Phantasialand / Efteling Theme Park
Sunday 8 th April	Tournament continues today and your team will play in the A finals or B finals (plate).
Monday 9 th April	Depart around lunchtime arrive in local area in the evening.

Extend your stay by an extra night for just £20 per person allowing you to have Monday free for sightseeing or a free day at Center Parcs.



Transport

Executive coach with video, toilet and hot drinks facility included free of charge for groups of 25 persons or more. Smaller groups will have luxury standard coaches suitable for the size of party; upgrades to executive vehicles are available and coach share may be possible for small groups.

Sailings are also available via Harwich – Hook (£25 per person), Hull – Rotterdam (£50 per person) and Newcastle – Amsterdam (£50 per person). Teams wishing to travel overnight (popular with North of England or Scottish clubs) can do so at a supplement of £20 per person. This would allow your group more time at your destination, meaning you would depart on Thursday and arrive in Holland earlier on the Friday.

The most suitable airports to fly into are Dusseldorf Niederrhein Weeze, Dusseldorf International or Eindhoven; transfers from here to your accommodation and sports grounds (approximately 30 minutes to 1 hour).

Accommodation Options



Center Parcs Het Heijderbos, Het Meerdal and Limburgse Peel are all in the heart of the tournament area.

Youth Hostels, Hotels, Holiday Villages are also available, prices on request.

Age dispensations may be applied for. All teams are split into groups of 4 or 5 teams playing each other on the first day. Teams finishing first or second in their group play in the A finals, all other teams play in the B finals (plate).

**Age Group Boys E and F plus girls D and E are 7 a side competitions. Elite sections for professional clubs and representative teams are available. More than 40 grass pitches in 10 locations are made available for this event.

History

2012 marks the 12th Holland Easter Open, more than 400 teams are expected to participate in the biggest Easter tournament in Europe. Teams from Holland, Belgium, Germany, Denmark, Sweden, Austria, Hungary, Italy, USA, England, Scotland and Wales have played in the tournament.

Location

The tournament is held in the towns of Venray, Gennep, Boxmeer and nearby villages in the east of Holland close to the German border and within 40 minutes of Eindhoven, Venlo, Nijmegen and Arnhem.

Social Programme

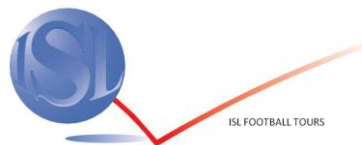
